Columbia Grain International Acquires New Facility in Minto, ND and Announces New Hires

The Minto location houses two grain elevators and has an 840,000-bu capacity.

It is located 32 miles from Arvilla, and 33 miles from Crystal,” said CGI’s Senior VP of the Grain Division, Kurt Haarmann. “This acquisition will help us to better serve growers in Minto, and the surrounding areas, by providing another harvest location for wheat, soybeans, corn, dry edible beans, and specialty crops.”
